plan points

- Bumping out the east wall by 2 feet accommodates a refrigerator, two wall ovens, a baking center, and coat closet.
- A new peninsula now houses the sink and dishwasher, freeing the north wall for a small triangular expansion. One side of the triangle is a floor-to-ceiling window; the other is a leaded glass door, which connects the kitchen to the deck. Both bathe the kitchen in natural light.
- Arranging the stove, sink, and refrigerator into a compact work triangle creates an efficient work space.
